## Pediatric Wellness Program for Kittens

*The first step in a lifelong health care plan for your companion*

**Philosophy Statement:** We treasure the unique family-pet bond by providing comprehensive, high-quality veterinary care with emphasis on exceptional client service and patient care. We promote this level of service by keeping current on medical advances, offering continuing education for our health care team, and being compassionate and understanding towards pets and those who love them.

In support of our philosophy statement we are offering a well kitten care program to ensure the newest member of your family has everything he or she needs to get a good start in life.

**This plan includes:**

- ♥ **Four kitten visits & 1 biannual examination** – Initial visits are important for many reasons. Your veterinarian is your pet's pediatrician, dentist, surgeon, optometrist, and psychologist.
- ♥ **Additional exams and office** calls throughout the year are done at ***no charge!***
- ♥ **2 Feline Leukemia / Feline Immunodeficiency Virus Tests** – All kittens should be tested at 9 weeks of age or older and retested 6-12 weeks later. This **includes 2 heartworm** tests as well.
- ♥ **Vaccinations included:**
  - ♥ 3 Panleukopenia/Calicivirus/Rhinotracheitis vaccinations
  - ♥ 1 Rabies vaccination
  - ♥ 2 Feline Leukemia vaccinations
- ♥ **3 Fecal exams** for intestinal parasites
- ♥ **2 Dewormings** for roundworms and hookworms – these common parasites may be transmitted to people.
- ♥ **Your Kittens first year of Heartgard tablets** for heartworm and hookworm prevention
- ♥ **Microchipping and Registration** provides your pet with safe and comfortable permanent identification
- ♥ **Health Screen Bloodwork** - checks blood cell count levels, kidney and liver functions, helps establish baseline normal values for each individual pet, and helps us to uncover and resolve medical problems early. This bloodwork is required prior to spaying, neutering, declawing, or any other anesthetic procedure.
- ♥ **Behavior/Training Topics** - discussed and reviewed at each visit to help you have a well mannered pet
- ♥ **Nail Trims** – done at each of the 4 kitten visits if necessary at no charge!
- ♥ **Free Bag of Kitten food**

- **10% off spay or neuter**- if done before 7 months of age (or within 1 month of their first visit if already over 7 months)

- **5% off Frontline Plus, dentistry services AND Pet Accommodation Stays (Boarding & Daycare)**

**The total healthcare package for your kitten is \$521.68 or \$43.48 per month on our automatic withdrawal plan.**

**(Regularly \$791.68)**

**Saves \$270.00**

The Program can be paid for at the first visit or divided between the first two visits using hold checks, hold credit card slips, or you may choose to make monthly payments using our automatic withdrawal plan.
