Wellness Care Program Avian & Exotics

Philosophy Statement: *We treasure the unique family-pet bond by providing comprehensive, high-quality veterinary care with emphasis on exceptional client service and patient care. We promote this level of service by keeping current on medical advances, offering continuing education for our health care team, and being compassionate and understanding towards pets and those who love them.*

- ♥ **Annual and biannual exams** are important for many reasons. Pets age faster than people (especially non-traditional pets), non traditional pets hide illnesses because in nature sick and weak animals are preyed upon, and pets cannot talk so they cannot tell you when or where it hurts. Your veterinarian is your pet's doctor, surgeon, dentist, optometrist, and psychologist. (one of each per wellness plan)
- ♥ **Additional outpatient exams and office calls** throughout the year are done at *no charge*.
- ♥ **Fecal testing** to check for parasites that are in the environment year round. The Center for Disease Control recommends twice a year fecal testing and strategic deworming of pets due to the diseases and parasites that can also infect people.
- ♥ **Yearly well-pet blood and urine testing** checking blood cell count levels, kidney, liver, protein, blood sugar and many other levels, helps establish baseline normal values for each individual pet, provides a way of finding decreasing function before it reaches a critical disease state, and helps us to uncover and resolve medical problems early, before they cause unnecessary pain, illness and expense. These tests are especially important in avian and exotic pets because there is so much less known about their normal values and responses. If we can develop normal values for your specific companion then we will be able to better interpret results when they are not feeling well.
